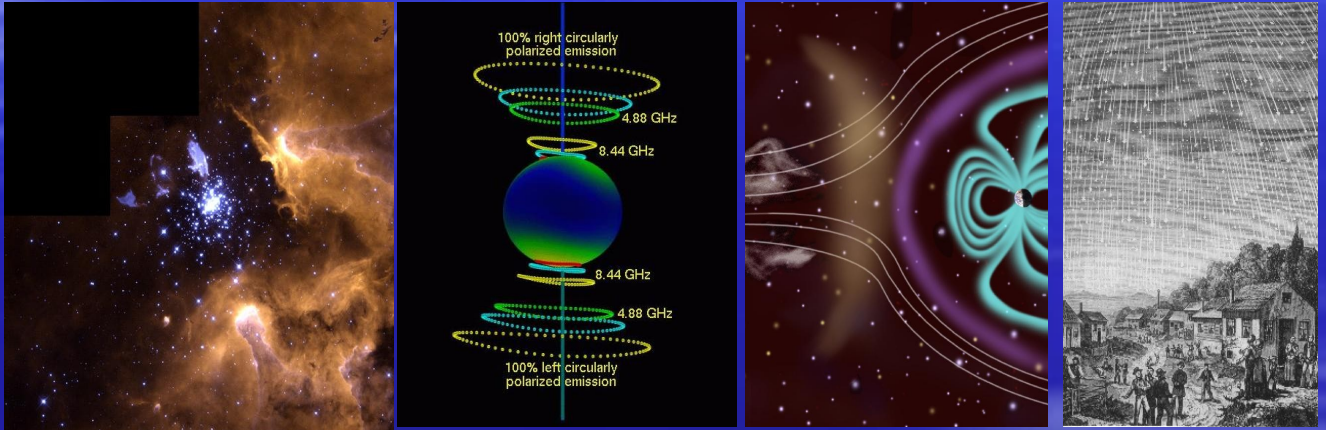


Postgraduate Studentships

Applications are invited for postgraduate studentships at Armagh Observatory from 2008 October 1.

Armagh Observatory, located in Northern Ireland, has been at the forefront of astronomical research for more than two hundred years. Research interests include Solar Physics, Solar-System Science, Stellar and Galactic Astrophysics. There are 8 staff astronomers, 4–6 post-doctoral fellows, and a dozen PhD students. Candidates must have, or expect to obtain, at least an upper second class honours degree or equivalent. Successful candidates will enroll at appropriate universities and carry out a research programme at the Armagh Observatory. Applications are encouraged from candidates of any nationality.

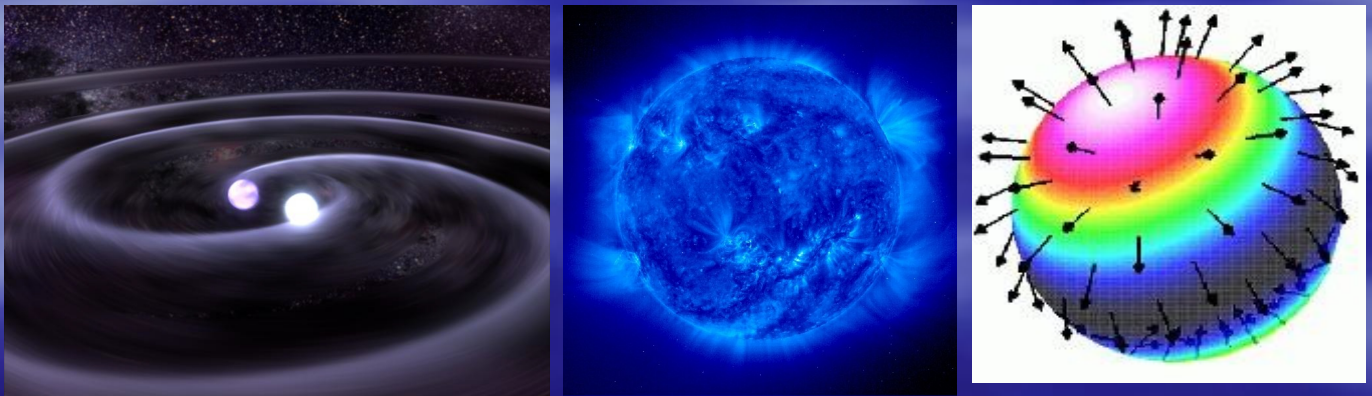
